

KAWASAKI PARTICIPATION

The Kawasaki Aircraft Company sent two engineers, Mr. Tetsuya Tanimoto: Chief of Research Section Export Department, and Akio Tanaka: Chief of Planning Section Engine Division, to South Lake Tahoe to test the Snow Eagle.

After testing the unique machine (see photo), they returned to Japan to develop an engine for it. This engine is known as the KT300. It will outperform any existing engine on the market to develop torque at its lower RPM and making it ideal for use at high elevation.

Besides agreeing to supply engines for Fullerton Design, the Kawasaki Company is negotiating with McCormack International for the right to produce machines similar to the Snow Eagle. These machines would bear the Kawasaki name, while the Kawasaki Company would pay royalties for rights granted.
